Three-Time National champion Atlantic Brass Band returning to Balic Winery

The band has also performed internationally with a tour of Italy and 2 tours of England, and most recently travelled to the Netherlands to compete in the World Brass Band Championship in July of 2013.

The band's repertoire continues to include a wide variety of solo performances, contest literature, small ensemble works, and a broad selection from opera, jazz, ragtime, Broadway and movie soundtracks, to name a few. In 2013 ABB released their latest CD "The Spirit of Christmas" and last month finished recording their next CD, "Metropolis" which is due out in October.

Atlantic Brass Band is the Ensemble-in-Residence at Rowan University in Glassboro, New Jersey, and was originally formed as the Wheaton Brass Band by Yorkshire-born Herb Roselle.

Atlantic has designed a program for Balic to delight all musical tastes and styles including marches, operatic excerpts, pop tunes, jazz and more. The band will perform two concerts beginning at 1 PM and 3 PM. Admission is free and open to the public.
